Clawson Police Department School Liaison Scholarship Program

1. Purpose:

This scholarship was established in 2010 to give recognition to any graduating senior who wishes to pursue a career within the Criminal Justice System

2. Eligibility:

- A. Must be a graduating senior who attends Clawson High School or a Clawson resident who is a graduating senior at another local high school.
- B. Must be planning to attend a post-secondary school program with a focus in Criminal Justice or Law Enforcement.
- C. Must have a minimum cumulative High School GPA of 2.5

3. Criteria for Screening Candidates:

- A. Must submit two letters of recommendation from a teacher, counselor, coach or clergy member.
- B. Must submit a short-written essay about yourself and your career goals (See Application)
- C. Must demonstrate active participation in school and/or community activities, a sound character, and leadership ability.

4. Amount:

The dollar amount and number of scholarships awarded will be based upon the amount of money raised at the Annual Spring Fundraiser. This will be determined by the Chair or Organizing Officer each year.

**Deadline for application to be submitted to the CHS Counselor's Office or the Clawson Police Department is May 12th, 2024.

**This is a non-renewable scholarship that must be used for tuition or books during the 2024-2025 academic years. The scholarship check will be awarded upon proof of registration at an accredited institution of continuing education (College or University)
