- Has fulfilled all 9th and 10th grade MMC requirements by the end of 10th grade
- Oakland Technical EC Application (Online Application, Counselor Recommendation Form, Commitment Essay, OCC Application and testing with qualifying placement scores)
- Education Development Plan aligned with OSTC program/Early College Program of Study
- Attend 2 Day Summer Workshop in August prior to starting 11th grade
- Personal transportation is needed for coursework at any Oakland Community College location
